What is More than Skin Deep?

More than Skin Deep – Children and Young People – Health Professionals is a self-paced, online learning program that has been developed for health professionals and support staff working with children and young people who have sustained a burn injury.

What is the aim of the program?

The overall aim of the learning program is to enhance the delivery of psychosocial care for children, young people and their families in order to improve outcomes and quality of life following a burn injury.

What is in the learning program?

There are five modules. Each module consists of on-screen information, podcasts, animations, self-knowledge check activities, readable and downloadable resources, and videos.

At the end of each module there is a downloadable PDF of content introduced throughout the module. There is also a pre- and post-survey embedded into the learning program. These surveys provide the Fiona Wood Foundation with the opportunity to evaluate the learning program and determine areas for improvement. The surveys also provide an opportunity for self-reflection.

A Certificate of Completion can be downloaded after completing the final module in the learning program.

Are there any pre-requisites and how many hours will it take?

There are no pre-requisites, and it will take approximately three hours to complete.



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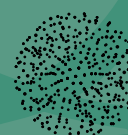
